

2011-12 NCVF BOARD APPROVED GOVERNANCE RULE CHANGES

The following resolutions were approved by the NCVF Board of Directors in response to recommendations made at the 2011 NCVF Advisory Council Meeting in Chicago this summer. Clarifications and minor changes to the Governance Rules will be crafted to implement these resolutions. *All but one are effective for the 2012 NCVF Competitive Season.*

1. The NCVF does not recognize the appeal decisions or eligibility determinations of any other institution or organization. Any player not in compliance with NCVF rules must file an appeal with the NCVF Compliance Committee.

This rule change is considered a minor rule change.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Current Season (2012)

2. Players from recognized 2-year schools are limited to three consecutive years of NCVF eligibility. If a player from a recognized 2-year school transfers to a 4-year university, that player's eligibility will be considered under the six-year consecutive rule.

This rule change is considered a major change.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Not until the 2012-13 Season
